CYCLE ENFIELD PLOWS ON

Cycle Enfield, Enfield Council's notorious cycle scheme is now under construction along the A105, causing severe congestion, pollution and affecting local businesses.

Furthermore, approval was recently given by the Council to a cycle lane scheme in Enfield Town itself and Hertford Rd! The Council is putting in £12m of its own funds into a scheme that most residents don't support!

The Conservatives in Enfield Southgate strongly support more people cycling in the Borough, but we believe that these cycle routes should have been installed along less busy routes. This approach was proposed during the consultation period by Conservative representatives but was turned down by the

GLA and the Council.

The Cycle Lane will hold up buses using this busy road; create more traffic congestion and pollution; and reduce the passing trade that local shops depend on for their survival.

If we get into power in the next local elections in 2018, we would stop any further construction and review what has already been built, whilst consulting residents.

David Burrowes MP is committed to tackling air quality, but believes more targeted measures that will make a real difference are needed.

FLY-TIPPING EPIDEMIC

Under the Labour run Council, Enfield has become the second worst-affected area for fly-tipping in England*. Fly-tipping is ruining our local community and costing the tax-payers millions of pounds. RELATIONSHIP AND SEX ED LESSONS NOW COMPULSORY
